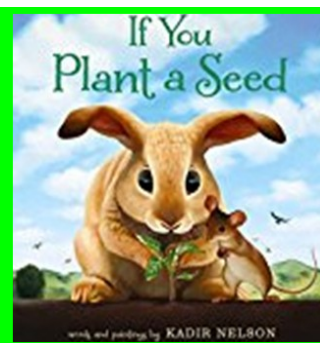
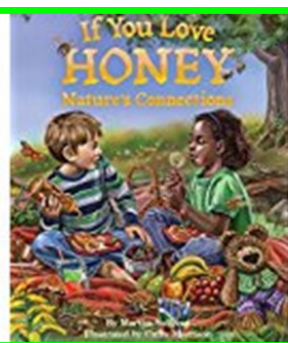
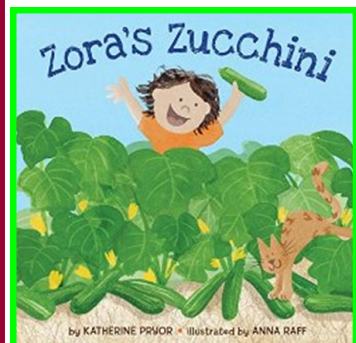
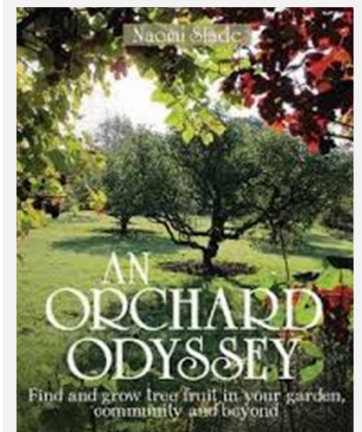
Plant: Art of the Botanical World by Phaidon Editors
