Join Summit County Extension Educator, Danae Wolfe, for a two-part series (worth 8 CEs) to learn the basics of garden photography. The primary focus will be on shooting flowers & insects using a variety of close-up and macro techniques.

Saturday, August 17: 10am-3pm

Part 1: Intro to Macro Photography

This introductory course will include the basics of photography. We'll cover photography equipment, creative (and inexpensive) macro techniques, and using your camera to capture great images.

Saturday, August 24: 10am-3pm

Part 2: Field Work & Critiques

For this course, we will head outside for a hands-on photography field session. We'll focus on mastering your equipment, learning to see like a photographer, & composing beautiful shots. After the field session, we'll head inside for a constructive critique of the photos you took!

*Please bring your photography equipment (camera, lenses, etc.). Although the primary focus will be on learning to use DSLR cameras, point & shooters are welcome to come & learn!

Course fee is \$50 if you register by August 1. After August 1, course fee is \$60. Fee includes materials & lunch for both sessions. All classroom work will take place at the Summit County Extension Office (2525 State Rd., Cuyahoga Falls, OH 44223). Field session location TBA.
