Diagnostic Workshop

What: Join other MGVs who love to learn and hone your diagnostic skills at the same time! The class includes two individual presentations in the morning. Ashley Kulhanek will focus on "Entomology 201: Refreshers, Notable Pests, and Invasives on the Horizon." She will provide a short refresher of basic entomology, discuss pests of note for the season and alert you to possible invasive pests on the horizon for Ohio. Pam Bennett, State Master Gardener Program Director and Horticulture Educator will focus on "Pests in Herbaceous Plantings" and will discuss the most common pests and their management. In the afternoon you will have an opportunity to practice your skills. There will be hands-on samples for you to practice the diagnostic process, allowing you to increase your confidence in diagnosing plant problems.
