- •Presentations are installed under MG Presentation icon


Using A CD or Memory Stick

•Presentations can be run from a CD, or memory stick, but for best results, presentations should be installed on computer









Using The Remote Control

- •Use "Next" or "Previous" to Move Through Slides
- •Hit Power Button Twice to Turn Projector Lamp Off
- •Blue Light Remains Steady as Fan Cools Bulb
- Do Not Unplug Projector until blue light blinks

Ending a Power Point Program : Dell Projector

- 1.Double click 'POWER" button on remote or push on/off button on top of projector twice. Blue light remains steady as fan cools bulb.
- 2. Wait until blue light blinks, then unplug power cord.

Ending a Power Point Program: Dell Projector 3. Replace lens cap. 4.Lower rear feet. 5.Hold in 'height" button and push front foot up. 6.Pack up projector and projector cord into projector case.



Ending a Power Point Program:Dell Computer 1.Use mouse, go to "file" in upper right hand corner. Click on "close". 2. Remove CD if used. 3.Use mouse, single click on "start" In lower left hand corner of screen. 4.Use mouse, click on "turn off Computer"

Ending a Power Point Program: Dell Computer 5. Use mouse, click on "turn off". 6. Unplug computer from wall. 7.Remove power cord, gold USB connector, blue connector and mouse from computer.

Ending a Power Point Program:Dell Computer 8. Place computer in carrying case. 9. Return mouse to pocket. 10. Place cords in computer carrying case.
